WORKS: CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING IMPROVEMENT SCHEME

HIGH STREET SOUTHGATE N14 (SOUTHGATE COLLEGE TO SOUTHGATE CIRCUS)

ROAD CLOSURE: TUESDAY 1ST OCTOBER TO WEDNESDAY 2ND OCTOBER 2024

NIGHTWORKS –BETWEEN HOURS 20:00 HRS TO 05:00 HRS

As part of Enfield's investment for 2024/2025 in the Borough's highway infrastructure, the above road has been identified as requiring resurfacing.

In order to minimise the disruption these works may cause we would be grateful if you would **refrain from parking or leaving vehicles on the above road whilst these works are being carried out.**

Please note that:

- Any vehicles left on the highway during this time that are affecting the works will be relocated, to a nearby, safe location, by an authorised car removal company.
- Residents may be provided with access to their properties returning home during this time. However, in certain circumstances we may not be able to do this and will ask you to park in the nearest available side road until the works are completed. Before and after these times the road should be open for full access.

- As detailed above our night works programme generally commences at around 20:00 and should the works take place without undue delay will finish by 05:00. Due to the works process the noisiest activities i.e. removing the old surface and breaking out around manhole covers in the road will take place first, finishing at around 00:00. After this, laying the new surface is a relatively quiet process with the main noise caused by the reversing sirens on vehicles, which are compulsory due to health and safety regulations.
- In order to minimise noise all contractors' plant is equipped with engine silencers, and we ask that any vehicles not in use are turned off. We will also have an engineer on site to monitor the works ensuring that the contractor is performing to our required standards.

The works will be carried out in four stages as follows:

- Carriageway planing and associated works.
- Adjustment of ironwork.
- Machine laying of surfacing material.
- Reinstatement of road markings.

The scheduled dates could be subject to change due to any unforeseen circumstances and we ask you to comply with any no parking cones or spray paint markings that may appear on the carriageway.

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause, and should you have any queries, do not hesitate to contact us on the above email address as we will be only too pleased to help.

Finally, a message from Enfield Trading Standards. We would like to warn you against rogue traders claiming to be council contractors and offering to carry out private work. **No Enfield Council contractor will tout for business door to door.
