PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENT SCHEME

Road Name: Lakenheath N14 (Saxon Way to Chase Road) South side

As part of the investment in Enfield's highway infrastructure for the Borough, a section of the above road has been identified for pavement improvement (see plan overleaf). This will involve reinstating a higher kerb face where possible and replacing the pavement with asphalt in accordance with Enfield's Highway Maintenance Policy.

The work is scheduled to start week commencing **Monday 9th February 2026** and will last for approximately **5 weeks**. Please note that the dates could be subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. You will be advised of the exact start date nearer the time.

Further information on the pavement renewal programme can be found on the Council's website, under the heading **More Services** click: **Roads and transport > Road and pavement maintenance**. The map shows the London Borough of Enfield. Zoom into the map to find planned road and pavement works in your area.

Your help with parking will enable works to be carried out with as little delay as possible and we therefore ask you to comply with any no parking cones and signs. If you are directly affected by the works, you may not be able to access your drive whilst works are undertaken outside your property, therefore we suggest you find alternative suitable on-street parking.

Please note that:

- **Any vehicles left on the highway during this time that are affecting the works may be relocated, to a nearby, safe location, by an authorised car removal company.**

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause and should you have any queries or concerns during these works, please contact us using the email address above.

Finally, a message from Enfield Trading Standards. We would like to warn you against rogue traders claiming to be council contractors and offering to carry out private work. **No Enfield Council contractor will tout for business door to door.
