**THE BOURNE N14 (NO.34 TO SOUTHGATE CIRCUS)**

**ROAD CLOSURE:**  
**RESURFACING: WEDNESDAY 18TH TO THURSDAY 19TH MARCH 2026**  
**ANTI-SKID REINSTATEMENT: FRIDAY 3rd APRIL**

**21:00hrs to 05:00hrs**

As part of Enfield's investment for 2025/2026 in the Borough's highway infrastructure, a section of the above road has been identified as requiring resurfacing.

In order to minimise the disruption these works may cause we would be grateful if you would **refrain from parking or leaving vehicles on the above road whilst these works are being carried out.**

Please note that:

- Any vehicles left on the highway during this time that are affecting the works will be relocated, to a nearby, safe location, by an authorised car removal company.
- As the works are being undertaken under a road closure between **21:00 and 05:00**, we will restrict access to the site to **EMERGENCY VEHICLES ONLY**.
- One Way restrictions on Bournside Crescent and Tudor Road will be rescinded during working hours. Vehicles will be able to enter and leave Bournside Crescent from High St N14 and Tudor Road from Winchmore Hill Road. Parking will also be restricted on Tudor Road to accommodate two - way traffic.

- Residents may be provided with access to their properties returning home during this time. However, in certain circumstances we may not be able to do this and will ask you to park in the nearest available side road until the works are completed.
- Before and after these times the road should be open for full access, subject to weather conditions.
- If you have a disabled persons parking bay you will need to contact [traffic@enfield.gov.uk](mailto:traffic@enfield.gov.uk) immediately to advise us that the bay is still needed. If we receive no communication from you the bay **will not** be put back once the resurfacing has been completed.

The works will be carried out in five stages as follows:

1. Carriageway planing.
2. Adjustment/ Replacement of ironworks.
3. Machine laying of surfacing material.
4. Reinstatement of road markings.
5. Reinstatement of Anti-skid surfacing

The scheduled dates could be subject to change due to any unforeseen circumstances and we ask you to comply with any no parking cones or spray paint markings that may appear on the carriageway.

We would like to take this opportunity to apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause and should you have any queries, do not hesitate to contact us on the above email address as we will be only too pleased to help.

**Finally, a message from Enfield Trading Standards.** We would like to warn you against rogue traders claiming to be council contractors and offering to carry out private work. **No Enfield Council contractor will tout for business door to door.
